

Heather PRENDERGAST's diverse immigration practice focuses on complex removal defense including trials, appeals, and federal court litigation; employment-based immigration for skilled professionals; family-based immigration; asylum; and naturalization.

She is one of 21 Directors elected to serve on the Board of Governors for the Washington, D.C. based American Immigration Lawyers Association (AILA), the premier bar association of more than 15,000 immigration attorneys and law professors. Heather regularly speaks about immigration issues at local, regional, and national conferences, serves on conference planning committees, and is an Adjunct Law Professor at Cleveland State University's Cleveland-Marshall College of Law. Her remarks have been quoted in *Rolling Stone*, *the Wall Street Journal*, *Associated Press*, *Bloomberg Law*, *the San Francisco Chronicle*, as well as other publications.
