Officer In Charge (OIC) Juan Agudelo began his career with the United States Department of Homeland Security on December 21, 2002, with the Transportation Security Administration in Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

In September of 2006, Mr. Agudelo entered on duty with Immigration and Customs Enforcement as an Immigration Enforcement Agent in the Miami Field Office. Since then, he has risen through the ranks of ERO; promoting to Deportation Officer, Supervisory Detention and Deportation Officer, Assistant Officer in Charge and Assistant Field Office Director. In 2019, he accepted the position of OIC in the Miami Field Office overseeing the Broward Transitional Center and Miami International Airport Operations Unit.

Mr. Agudelo has held several leadership positions within the Miami Field Office to include the Intelligence Operations Unit, Fugitive Operations, Criminal Alien Program, Detention and Transportation, and Detained Case Management.

Mr. Agudelo's career highlights include leading a highly successful and nationally recognized Intelligence Operations Unit that received the ERO Outstanding Enforcement Accomplishment award in 2015 and the ICE Directors award for Protecting the Homeland in 2017.
